Mike Lovely called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

In attendance were Mike, Joe Barry, Gene Duncan and Pam Nettleton.

Joe Barry reported that the checkbook has a balance of \$3,424.67.

The most pressing issue for the meeting was the upcoming October 22nd General Meeting.

Cricket Kadoch has reserved the meeting room at Pine Ridge Elementary School as well as for the April General Meeting.

The cost for the school included \$75 (up \$15) for the rental, \$76 for extra clean-up (because of the ice cream), and a \$20 scheduling fee; totaling \$171 for the room rental.

Mike will get details of the meeting to Marty King so she can draw up the mailer.

It was decided that \$200 would be budgeted for the purchase of the ice cream and supplies. Pam is to acquire the paper goods and whatever else is needed.

Weather permitting, the ice cream is to be served and consumed outside the building.

The board is to at the school at 5:30 to set up and prepare for the ice cream social which would begin at 6:00 along with the viewing of the firetruck. The general meeting would begin at 7:00.

For the purpose of the survey, the Board is not sure if they are aware of the concerns of the SBNA members so it will be taking suggestions at the general meeting to be included in the survey.

Dave Howe, who will be accompanying the fire truck will be one of the evening's speakers, addressing...?????????

And it is hoped that a representative from Art in Public Places will come address us concerning plans for the Powers round-about.

It seems Barb Campbell of the City Council is working on getting bus shelters for the neighborhoods.

Mike is following through on getting Joe and Pam's emails added to the TSAC list for notifications.

A land use approval was made for a variance from a 20 foot setback to a 15 foot for a home on Hitching Post Lane.
