The Old Farm District will be holding an emergency preparedness night on the same night as our General Meeting, April 28.

The group discussed the possibility of contacting Nathan Gariday to present information on the Cascadian earthquake subduction zone for the fall Gen. Meeting. That information could be put on the SBNA web site.
