Clean Up Day:

Landuse:

The city had an area meeting to discuss the cell tower planned on a small parcel of land next to Elk Meadow School. Elizabeth Szabo will be contacting the Bend/Lapine school board and will be petitioning the landowner. Judy Clinton has offered suggestions and information to this group and will continue to do so. The Landuse chairman has been replaced. Judy Clinton has agreed to accept that position after a vote of the attending board members. A letter is being sent to Mike Lovely, the previous chairman, explaining the change.

Treasurers Report:

Joe reported our association spent \$952.01 from our checking account on trash grabbers, safety vests, name badges and neighborhood brochures with a balance of \$2391.38. The City of Bend reimburses us for the \$952.0. This brings our checking account balance back up to the original amount of \$3,343.39 as of July 26th, 2019.

Safety Street Project:

Elizabeth explained the process of the program. The City of Bend in conjunction with the Neighborhood Leadership Alliance is accepting applications from the city residents until Sept. 20, 2019. We will be organizing a committee to review applications.
