Items discussed:

- 1) Mike will look in to getting some "Please Slow Down" signs that neighbors can put in their yards to remind drivers to slow down in neighborhoods. These are usually handed out for free at the County Fair. Kevin will see if he can find one and read where it came from. Pam will pick some up when the source is found. (Kevin found out they came from the Sheriff's Office booth at the fair.)
- 2) OLCC speaker went to a different neighborhood meeting tonight. She will attend our meeting another time and when she knows more officers will show up to the meeting.
- 3) At the General Membership meeting Cricket will make a brief presentation about Nextdoor.com and getting more people involved if they are not already.
- 4) Kevin will continue to maintain the website with important updates, but will not attend all meetings due to family matters.
- 5) We will announce at the General Meeting, openings for all of the available board member and member at large positions available on the SBNA board. If a knowledgeable webmaster type person can be found they can take some of the workload on for the website.
- 6) Transportation Safety Advisory Committee (TSAC) met Sept 16. Joe attended. Mike and Pam were busy. A lot of bike safety discussion. There was some discussion that the downtown business owners want to have the signals removed on Bond and Wall Streets at Oregon Street. Joe said many people were wondering how and why.
- 7) At the NART meeting, Mike will ask about the solar powered radar speed signs. We want to place them in the neighborhoods to remind people to slow down on neighborhood streets. Mike heard the Police were getting four more of the speed signs.
- 8) Mike needs someone to attend the NART meetings, so he can have a reduced meeting schedule. They are on the third Thursday at noon in the council board room.

- 9) Still many petty crimes being reported in our neighborhood by people on the Nextdoor.com. RAIDS online doesn't not seem to show many of the more major crimes down in our area of the city.
