Meeting called to order: 6:10pm

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer was absent.

Items discussed:

1. Minutes approved.
2. Teri Shamlian and the clean up committee have been doing a great job keeping Brookswood looking good and free from weeds and trash.
3. Deschutes River Woods gave SBNA an award at their annual meeting.
4. NART meeting information: www.ci.bend.or.us/index.aspx?page=43 and we will find a presentation given by Eric King the city manager, State of the City. We will share the link.
5. Land Use Issue over one Hobart Lane.
6. Brookswood Blvd will get more temporary paving this year from Pinebrook, south to the city limits, and curb to curb major overlay next year.
7. Space for the Fall General Meeting has been reserved at Pine Ridge Elementary.
8. Walmart is working on their big expansion to full grocery, but the road north of the building is not being widened.
9. Powers and Brookswood roundabout is under construction as of this past Monday. Should be finished by October 31st.
10. Powers/Brookswood Roundabout art will not be part of the latest round of funding. Mike would still like a logging arch, but some others have discussed putting an Elk sculpture in honor of Elk Meadow. We would still like the logging arch, and then possibly put an Elk Sculpture at the roundabout that will likely go to the Murphy Road eventually. It will be closer to Elk Meadow anyway.
11. We need a secretary for our neighborhood association.
12. Mike is trying to get the jail inmate crew out to clean up the weeds near the roundabout at Powers, but there is limited money in the budget this year.
13. Other methods to let people know about the General Meetings are Facebook (<https://www.facebook.com/SouthwestBend>) and Nextdoor.com (https://southwestbend.nextdoor.com/news_feed/), but will not get the audience of the Yellow Mailer Cards that we send out twice a year.
14. Matt updated us with traffic issues and trying to get a speed trailer on Lodgepole and Ponderosa to measure traffic speeds. Also mentioned a connector street from Chase to

Brosterhouse. It is already in the TSP (Transporation System Plan), and will improve east-west flow if this connection could go in sooner. We will write a NA letter in support of the Old Farm District letter.

15. Options for speakers at our General Meeting include the Art in Public Places group (roundabout art), and possibly a sustainability speaker from the Environmental Center. (Denise Rowcroft.)
16. Brookwood Meadow Plaza needs to renew their website advertising.
17. We would like to put together a list of all of the businesses in our NA, so we can contact them about putting an ad and/or coupon on the website to help drum up business for them from the neighbors.
